Petition for Declaratory Statement before the FL Building Commission Reference:

FBC Chapter 11 - Equivalent Facilitation for an Accessible Toilet Room Configuration

### **Dear Commission Members:**

This petition for a Declaratory Statement requests a determination of whether the toilet room configuration requirements of the federal 2010 Standards for Accessible Design is an acceptable alternative under the FL Building Code, Chapter 11 Section 2.2 Equivalent Facilitation.

11-2.2 Equivalent Facilitation. Departures from particular technical and scoping requirements of this code by the use of other designs and technologies are permitted where the alternative designs and technologies used will provide substantially equivalent or greater access to and usability of the facility.

The specific situation is the design of a small restaurant in an existing shopping center's tenant space in unincorporated Orange County. The design layout requires the toilet room door to swing into the clear floor space of the lavatory, which is not permitted in the current code.

However, the proposed layout of the toilet room does comply with the recently adopted federal 2010 Standards for Accessible Design, as stated in Exception 2 in Section 603.2.3.

## Section 603 Toilet and Bathing Rooms

"603.2.3 Door Swing. Doors shall not swing into the clear floor space or clearance required for any fixture. Doors shall be permitted to swing into the required turn area.

Exception 2: Where the toilet room or bathing room is for individual use and a clear floor space complying with 305.3 (30" x 48") is provided within the room beyond the arc of the door swing, doors shall be permitted to swing into the clear floor space or clearance required for any fixture."

The Orange County Building Official has indicated they will not allow the proposed toilet room layout under the Equivalent Facilitation provision and will enforce the current provision that does not allow the door to swing into the clear floor space of an accessible fixture.

As you may know, the adoption of the updated federal Standards was issued by the US Department of Justice on September 15, 2010. The implementation date for alterations and new construction in the updated standards is March 15, 2012, though the Justice Department specifically allows the use of the updated Standards immediately.

Additionally, as the Commission is aware, there is an ongoing workgroup assigned to generate a draft document for the Commission's review that incorporates the Florida specific accessibility requirements in FS 553.501 – 553.513 into the 2010 federal Standards. At the end of this process, the updated federal requirements will become the base document for Chapter 11 in the Florida Building Code. As such, the proposed layout will be an acceptable design, as early as the next edition of the Florida Building Code.

With this, we respectfully request a determination that allows the use of the "soon to be in the Florida Building Code" toilet room configuration as an acceptable alternative under FBC 11-2.2 Equivalent Facilitation. We firmly believe the proposed toilet room layout meets the criteria of providing equal or greater access.



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
