61G20-6.002 S p a p T a ir	Section 553.841(7), Florida Statutes, requires the Florida Building Commission to provide accreditation of courses related to the Florida Building Code via approved accreditors. Rule 61G20-6.002, F.A.C., establishes the criteria for approval of course providers, course accreditors and advance course accreditation by the Commission. The language needs to be amended to clarify the following: accreditors cannot accredit a course that does not comply with the Florida Building Code (inaccurate or incomplete); the Commission needs to be permitted to take action on courses that remain incomplete for more than 180 days; accredited courses require action by
