Letter to Mo Madani re Submission of Right-Energy/Florida 2014, July 12, 2017

- 1. Calculations of End Use Energy Loads uses different coefficients from those is Table B(1). We used the coefficients from Draft 2017 Code to recognize the 2015 Federal Minimum Equipment Efficiencies.
- 2. Solar DHW calculation equation 6-8 in 2014 TAM has an assumed typo and we replaced the TAM version with an equation as follows: ADHW = (ADHWc * (1-SF))
