Commissioner Schock welcomed Commissioners, staff, and members of the public to the October 17, 2017 Florida Building Commission Plenary Session Teleconference Meeting. # **Energy TAC's Recommendations:**

Commissioner Schock advised the Energy TAC met this morning and reviewed the EnergyGauge USA 6.0 software for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements and is recommending approval. In addition, the TAC reviewed Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) software for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements for new construction, single-family houses and is recommending conditional approval conditioned on the vendor correcting the program consistent with DBPR staff's comments.

Commissioner Brown joined the call updating the total members on the call to 18.

Commissioner Schock asked for a motion to conditionally approve the Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements form new construction, single-family houses, conditioned on the vendor correcting the program consistent with DBPR staff's comments.

# **Commissioner Comments:**

Commissioner Calleja stated he wanted to clarify that the Commission is approving the software only for compliance with the performance method 405 of the code not for any other method such as prescriptive or the ERI methodology.

Mr. Madani stated that Commissioner Calleja was correct the vote is only for performance.

Commissioner Calleja entered a motion to conditionally approve the Energy Code Compliance Software for the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation, specifically Right-Suite Universal 2017 (using Right-Energy Florida 2017) for demonstrating compliance with residential building energy requirements form new construction, single-family houses, conditioned on the vendor correcting the program consistent with DBPR staff's comments. Commissioner Boyer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 18 to 0.
