Regarding the above project:

The Zip Line Amusement Ride portion of the project is in a naturalistic setting and has unique design features, including tower structures. Per the structural design engineer for these towers, providing fully compliant ADA access to each feature would be infeasible without prohibitive expense. The course designer has, though, provided an accessible section of the course. See course and tower design documents and letter from Hubbard Merrell Engineering for full details. This accessible landing point is connected by an accessible route to the fully ADA accessible Welcome Center building and to provide ADA complaint accessible parking areas as required. This condition appears to comply with the spirit of the code section 234 – Amusement Rides.
