category in the BCIS and a title slide was missing from the presentation. He explained that when materials
were submitted incorrectly, the Commissioner's job of reviewing the course materials was much more difficult.
As a result, he recommended that this course be denied, instead of conditionally approved. Michael Clark,

	the Education Administrator, stated that both of Commissioner John's issues for this course were correct. However, he further stated that a course submitted in the wrong category was not covered under the current Rule language. He said that we can recommend how a course is submitted, but not deny that course if submitted differently. Justin V ogel (FBC legal counsel) stated that he could not find in the Rule language any references as to how a course is submitted. He also stated that the ED POC can't deny the course based on how it was submitted. As a result, the ED POC members agreed to conditionally approve the course. Mr. Clark stated that he would specifically remind both accreditors and providers to submit their course materials in the correct categories in the BCIS. Approved Unanimously
