This is a 1-hour online course that is designed to provide Florida contractors with a thorough understanding of the Wind Mitigation Retrofitting Techniques required by F.S. 553.844 as covered in the 2023 Florida Building Code. Licensees will become familiar with the techniques for improvement of roof-to-wall connections and adding or strengthening opening protections, including a review of pros and cons of approved products. It also covers component & cladding loads and answers many frequently asked questions.

Course: Advanced FBC Plumbing, 8th Edition (2023) – Appendix F Landscape Irrigation Systems - Internet

This is a 1-hour instructor led course that reviews & explains the key features & sections of the FBC as they relate to the practice of irrigation design, & subsequent irrigation system construction, for landscape architects. Sections of the Code, in particular Plumbing Appendix “F”, will be reviewed in regard to the practice of landscape architecture, & in relationship to the protection of the public health, safety & welfare in the design & construction of landscape irrigation systems.

- a. The number of ce hours, training provider name and contact information was missing from the title slide of the PowerPoint presentation
- b. “Instructor led” and “online” were listed as Method of Presentation. “Online” should be deleted.

As a result, I recommend denial of this course because it does not meet the full requirements of Rule 61G20-6.002. However, the ED POC could motion to instead conditionally approve this course, subject to adding the ce hours and training provider name and contact information to the title page of the PowerPoint presentation, and delete the term “online” in the Method of Presentation reference.
