I hope you have been doing well. I'm emailing regarding the note on [2026 FBC](#) request for comments.

I wanted to second the comment by Tim Hunt. We have certain jurisdictions that specifically request us to digitally sign documents and then print the digital signature out and physically notarize the document before they will take it. We have tried to explain that the digital signature should not be printed, and that to physically print it and then notarize it is actually not in compliance with the rules of digital signing, but we have been unsuccessful with that. I would highly suggest that we leave a section for digital signatures and have a specific note that says notarization is not required if the is document is digitally signed.
