Subject: comments on Proposed Forms based on HB 803 Private Provider Inspection Form Private Provider Certificate of Compliance Form

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Dear Mr. Madani,

Suggestions regarding the proposed forms posted as of 5/1/26:

1. Include the name of the Private Provider firm and the Private Provider individual in the header information on each form.
2. Omit or modify the statement on the Inspection form certifying conformance with the approved plans and applicable codes, since that could only be truthfully signed on a “passed” inspection. Could say something like “Inspected for conformance with the approved plans and the applicable codes.”
3. Format Certificate of Compliance to fit on one page.
4. Include the tax ID on the Certificate of Compliance (similar to the Notice to Building Official of Use of Private Provider).
5. On Certificate of Compliance, fix the typo in the statute note at the bottom “....employed full time by the private provider FIRM (not from).....”. Because of that statute provision, the signature line should also have a line for printed name and qualifying license.
6. Include source “Florida Building Commission” and effective date of the form.
7. I don’t see the need for owner name on the Inspection form, or applicant name and address on the Certificate of Compliance.
